What is Daughters of the Nile?



Top 10 Questions of a Prospective Member

1) Who are members of Daughters of the Nile?

Women, 18 years of age or older, who are related by birth or marriage to a Shriner, Master Mason, or Daughter of the Nile or is a majority member in Good Standing of a Masonic-related organization for girls; or who was a patient, with or without Shrine or Masonic relationship, at a Shriners Hospital for Children®.

2) What is the purpose of Daughters of the Nile?

Daughters of the Nile was founded for character building among women, social interaction and service to others. These ideals led to our work for the special children of Shriners Hospitals for Children®.

3) What philanthropy does Daughters of the Nile support?

Daughters of the Nile adopted Shriners Hospitals for Children® as its sole philanthropy in 1925 and has given over \$54 million thus far through the Daughters of the Nile Foundation and Canadian Foundation. Annual donations are in excess of \$2 million.

4) How do interested ladies become Daughters of the Nile?

Proposals to membership are signed by two members who are personally acquainted with the woman being proposed. A letter of invitation is then issued and candidates are conducted through the initiatory work at Ceremonials.

5) What are the benefits of belonging to Daughters of the Nile?

The members of Daughters of the Nile share a special bond of fellowship with each other. There is pride in our efforts toward supporting the great philanthropy of Shriners Hospitals for Children®.

6) Is Daughters of the Nile affiliated with a specific religion?

This organization is founded on a belief in the fatherhood of God and the sisterhood of women; thus, the organization is non-denominational. It is not a secret organization, but is a fraternity with secrets.

7) How do Daughters of the Nile support Shriners Hospitals for Children®?

Monetary donations to the Daughters of the Nile Foundation Convalescent Endowment Fund and Convalescent Relief Account, and the Canadian Foundation Convalescent Endowment and Relief Funds, provide support for patient care. Members also sew garments, donate toys, games, books, and other items to Shriners Hospitals for Children®. Some members volunteer at the hospitals and host parties for the children.

8) What is the Daughters of the Nile emblem?

The emblem is a scimitar with a suspended golden crescent whose center is a white rose. The colors of the Order are green, gold, and white.

9) Where is the birthplace of Daughters of the Nile?

Daughters of the Nile originated in Seattle, Washington in 1913 and celebrated its 100th anniversary in 2013.

10) How many subordinate temples of Daughters of the Nile exist, and where are they located?

There are 137 temples: 126 in the United States and 11 in Canada with membership in excess of 25,000.
