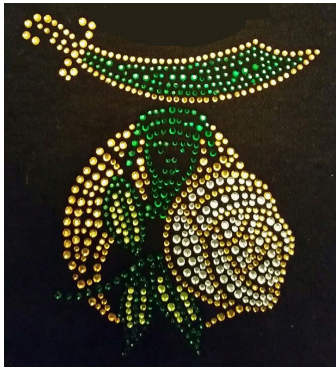




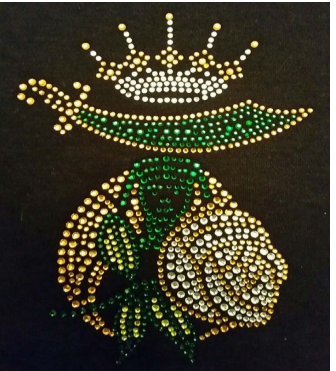

## Know the History of the 100 Supreme Sessions

Why is the "Royal Jubilee" convention the 100th Supreme Session??

Didn't we celebrate 100 years in 2013??

Daughters of the Nile WAS founded in 1913; but, this year in Indianapolis, Indiana we will be participating in the **100th Supreme Session**.

The Annual Supreme Sessions were canceled due to travel restrictions in wartime. The Secretary of War Administration prohibited holding large conventions during that time period. Since our Supreme Sessions were not held in 1943, 1944, and 1945, our 2016 convention holds the distinction of being our **100th!**
