Centennial Celebration in conjunction with the Official Visit of the Supreme Queer Saturday and Sunday, September 9th and 10th, 2017

Tirzah Temple was opened by then-Supreme Queen Minnie Jeffrey in June of 1917, and we are very proud of our long history as a part of this wonderful organization. Please join us in celebrating our 100th year by experiencing Butte, "the richest hill on earth", which is part of the largest National Historic District in the United States.

On Saturday, you can choose to view Butte from atop the Continental Divide, by riding up to Our Lady of the Rockies, a 90-foot statue in the likeness of Mary. Entirely nondenominational, it was dedicated by the workers to women everywhere. Sitting 8,510 feet above sea level and 3,500 feet above Butte, Our Lady is lighted and visible at night and is the best overlook of the area you can get.

If you'd rather see the town from the ground, we're taking a trolley tour through Uptown Butte. The trolley has been reserved just for Daughters of the Nile on this occasion, and a local expert will explain the Copper King Mansion, Dumas Brothel, World Museum of Mining, Berkeley Pit Viewing Stand, Mai Wah Museum, Clark Chateau, and more.

Whatever tour you choose, on Saturday evening we'll get together for an informal dinner at our Temple, enjoying each other's company without protocol but with some great food!

On Sunday morning there will be tours of our historic Temple, completed in 1902, which at its heyday was home to seven Masonic Blue Lodges, as well as Bagdad Shrine, two Eastern Star Chapters, each of the Masonic youth orders, Scottish Rite, York Rite, and of course Tirzah Temple.

After the tours we will host Her Supreme Majesty and other Dignitaries at our Banquet Luncheon, with formal introductions and a delicious meal.

Sunday afternoon all Daughters of the Nile are welcome at our Ceremonial, the Supreme Queen's Official Visit to our Temple.

Remember that all of our events other than the Ceremonial are open to all, so bring family and friends to enjoy western Montana. If you'd like to make a long weekend out of it, Sapphira Temple Number 79 in Helena will be hosting their Official Visit on Friday, September 8th, and Bath Zabbia Temple Number 21 in Billings on Monday, September 11th. Please RSVP directly to those Temples for their events. Montana is home to blue ribbon fishing, great golf, and beautiful vistas, and Butte is 2.5 hours from Yellowstone or 4 hours from Glacier National Park, so feel free to turn this into a vacation!

We look forward to hosting you during this weekend, and showing you some of the history of Butte, America!

Travel Information

Please be aware that Montana weather is uncertain, and tour events are subject to adjustment if snow arrives early.

Delta Airlines flies into Butte's Bert Mooney Airport (BTM) via Salt Lake City every day. Other airport options include Helena (HLN), which is about an hour drive, Bozeman (BZN), which is about 90 minutes, or Missoula (MSO), which is less than 2 hours.

Several major rental car companies operate out of Butte. The hotels provide free shuttle service from Bert Mooney Airport.

A block of discounted rooms has been reserved for the 9th and 10th.
